Misconduct, Metrics, and Motivation: Incentive-Driven Changes in Policing Behavior

This study investigates how publicly disclosed disciplinary actions against police officers alter police organizational activities by analyzing changes in key operational indicators such as arrest counts and clearance rates. Using disciplinary actions within the Tokyo Metropolitan Police Department as a quasiexperimental framework, the study identifies a temporary but significant improvement in police performance, notably a rise in theft arrests coinciding with the public disclosure of misconduct. These findings suggest that police organizations respond to reputational threats by reallocating resources to boost visible performance metrics. The evidence points to internal incentive structures, especially promotion-related motivations among police leadership, as the primary driver of these behavioral changes.
